2016 St Pete Boat Show Volunteer Info

What should I wear? Please wear clean, BCYC branded gear (hats, shirts, jacket, etc.). If you need a shirt, please contact Patti Tishuk – she has a selection to choose from.

Please check the weather as it can get quite hot in the tent and if the temperature dips, it can be quite chilly. Welcome to Florida in December!

When should I arrive? Please plan on arriving **about 15 minutes** before your scheduled time block. This will give you enough time to get to the Exhibitor's Only gate (between the Progress Energy Soccer Field and Mahaffey Theater).

Please see the attached Volunteer Schedule for your scheduled time block.

Where do I park? There is parking available at either the Dali Museum or at the Mahaffey Theater. Parking may be a challenge so be prepared!

Do I need a ticket for the Boat Show? If you plan on arriving very early or staying long past your scheduled time block, then yes, you should enter with a ticket. This will allow us to recycle our allotted Exhibitor Badges among the various volunteers throughout the four days. If you have any questions, please give Jenn a call.

Where do I get my Exhibitor Badge? You will pick up your Exhibitor's Badge at the Show Office and turn it back in when your time block is over. This allows the next volunteer to pick up their badge. We are only allowed a small number and must re-use them so it is essential that you return the Exhibitor Badge to the Show Office.

There are separate badges for both Setup (11/30) and Tear-down (12/4). I have these and will distribute them as needed to those who volunteered. These are specially labeled and cannot be used during the show itself.

Where is the BCYC booth? BCYC is in booth #133, in the narrower tent in front of the Mahaffey Theater.

Are there any rules? We have to stay within our booth space. We cannot "spill out" into the aisle. Also, we cannot play any music or turn up the volume on the DVD player.

What should I talk about?

This is a recruiting event! We want to stress our sailing activities: Adult Sail School, Youth Sailing, Racing, Cruising, Sea Scouts, etc. We are sailors first, social club second. Please familiarize yourself with our website: www.sailbcyc.org for lots of information on all the things we have to offer.

We have scheduled a follow-up event for those individuals/families who are interested in visiting our club and checking us out in more detail. This is our **Discover BCYC!** event scheduled for Saturday, December 31st from 10am – 12pm. Please hand out the blue invitations and encourage prospective members to sign up and attend.

We will have a DVD showing all our sailing adventures, a map showing our location and where we sail and a variety of Windword newsletters to show prospective members all that we offer. In addition, we will have a raffle (see below) and some other materials for distribution.

Do we have a raffle?

Yes! We will be raffling off ONE Adult Sail School registration that is good for any session that is offered in 2017! This is a \$250 dollar value and it is NOT transferable.

Anyone interested in entering the raffle must fill out a raffle form (yellow). The name on the raffle form will be the name on the registration and it is NOT transferrable! Also, the raffle is for ages 18 and older - this is a firm policy. Anyone under the age of 18 is encouraged to check out Youth Sailing and/or the Sea Scouts.

The winner will be selected from the raffle forms collected during the boat show (December 1st through the 4th). The drawing will be held on December 5th and announced at the Board Meeting.

What is Discover BCYC?

This is a free event that we encourage all prospective members to register for and attend. It is a 2-hour event held at BCYC where we introduce all the events and activities that we have to offer followed by a Q&A panel with various Committee Chairs and then a tour of the facilities. There will be flyers available to promote this event.

Will food or beverages be provided?

No but you are welcome to bring your own food and beverages (within reason and non-alcoholic).

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Do you have any tips?

- Our purpose is to generate interest in BCYC, specifically membership
 - Be courteous, acknowledge everyone immediately
 - Offer information about BCYC
 - Be enthusiastic – talk about your favorite aspects of BCYC: Sail School, Cruising, Racing, Christmas Lighted Boat Parade, Tuesday night racing, Fun Day, Raft-Up, etc.
 - Have people hand you their raffle form to make sure it is legible – if we can't read it, they can't win
 - If all they want is basic info, that's ok
 - If they are interested in membership, hand out a Discover BCYC! flyer and direct them to the website to register (it's free!)
 - Ask if they have youngsters – we have Youth Sailing and Sea Scouts
 - Mention the website/show the website
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What about Setup / Breakdown?

Those who have volunteered to help Setup: we will meet at the club at 8:30am on 11/30. In past years, it has taken us about 3 hours to set up the booth.

Those who have volunteered to help with Breakdown: we will start packing up the booth at 4:00pm on 12/4. This tends to take about 30 minutes to break everything down and pack it up. We will have to cart everything to the parking area as we will not be allowed to bring a vehicle into the staging area.
