Article I Name

The name "Rhumb Runners" was established in 1979.

Article II Mission Statement

The mission of Rhumb Runners is to provide venues for the women of Boca Ciega Yacht Club who are interested in sailing, social activities, community involvement, fellowship, and fun. Our commitment is to offer educational opportunities that will build confidence and foster independence while promoting the sport of sailing. We welcome all women regardless of where their interests lie, both on and off the water.

Article III Membership

All club women are welcome who have an interest in the sport of sailing.

Article IV Organizational Memberships

Through Boca Ciega Yacht Club, Rhumb Runners hold memberships in Florida Sailing Association and United States Sailing Association and Florida Women's Sailing Association.

Article V Officers and term of Duty

Rhumb Runner Officers are volunteer positions and consist of a Captain, Vice Captain, Sailing/Racing Chair, Secretary, and Treasurer. The Advisory Board consists of the afore mentioned and includes the current Past Captain and one member at large. New officers are selected in May. Term of duty starts the first day of June and ends the last day in May.

Article VI Meeting Day

Rhumb Runner monthly meetings are on the 3rd Saturday following the 3rd Friday of the month. The Advisory Board will meet at least four times a year. Sailing and racing events occur on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of the month. Additional sailing opportunities are offered at the convenience of the Sailing/Racing Chair.

Article VII Amending the Constitution

Any revisions or additions to the Constitution shall require a two thirds vote during a monthly meeting by those members present. Notice of a proposed change shall be included in the agenda that is sent out prior to the meeting.
